### **Professional Carrer**

## • Project HOPE Director

In 1991 applied to an advertisement by Project **HOPE**, (A non -governmental organization based in Virginia, USA aimed at "**Health Opportunities for People Everywhere**) requesting the employment of long- term consultant which was the beginning of a long- term employment with HOPE deputy Director 1993 and in the same year obtained Professor status Medical Surgical Faculty of Nursing Cairo University. Following, chosen to be **HOPE Egypt director** 1995-2003.

During her Employment with Project HOPE, Dr. Hoda developed and conducted several Nursing development projects with the Ministry of Health, and Ministry of Higher Education such as:

- Development of National Training Institute,
- University clinical model units,
- -Upgrade of Nursing curriculums with the assistance of university academics in different specialties.
- Developed Negotiation and fund-raising skills.
- During the time with Project HOPE several fund-raising efforts supported Nursing education and training efforts.

# • Undersecretary for Nursing, Ministry of Health & Population

Major achievement when seconded to the Ministry of Health and population on the request of the Minister 2006-2009, Redefining the preworkforce, Nursing education, secondary school nursing education extended to 5 years and new curricula were developed

where material at the secondary level to those who decided to join nursing early on in their lives as well are relevant to Nursing education with the assistance of Ministry of Education Center of curricula development with the aim to graduate two levels of Nursing workforce, Diploma and bachelor degree, consequently gradually diminishing admissions to what was known as schools of nursing to Institutes of Nursing. Graduates of the diploma level would have a chance to join the University and obtain a bachelor's degree.

To complement this change Nursing Uniforms were unified, created the position of Research Nurse, similar to Infection control nurse and Quality nurse.

The final career step 2010 is Dean to the faculty of Nursing, Modern University for Technology, and Information with the selection of innovative, passionate and resilient colleagues developed and conducting an education program that has been recognized by **NAQAA** to obtain accreditation as the first private Nursing Faculty to acclaim this status.
